The following is a list of supplies I recommend, BUT DO NOT FEEL IT IS NECESSARY TO DUPLICATE THE LIST EXACTLY!!! Bring the supplies that you are familiar using. Don't forget to bring along an open mind, creativity and the willingness to experiment and have fun!

I will have the basic white rice paper for sale. This is used most of all.

Specialty Items you will need to bring:

- 1. Collage papers [any colors] You can find these in most art supply catalogs
- 2. Glue [I prefer Weld Bond or Decoupage or Yes Glue] NOT ELMER'S GLUE
- 3. Old brushes for gluing
- 4. 140# or 300# watercolor paper [can be the back of a failed painting] I will use a quarter sheet of paper, 11"x15"
- 5. Interesting wrapping paper or napkins
- 6. Permanent black ink pens, various tip sizes

BRUSHES

1 inch flat, aquarella type, Round brushes, #6, #8 Don't for get an old brush for gluing!

PAINT-- Your regular watercolor paint will be fine for this project

WATER CONTAINER-- A container that holds at least one quart of water.

PALETTE-- Bring old faithful!

PAPER TOWELING-- I like to use VIVA

PENCIL-- #2H [Standard pencil] A KNEADED ERASER

SCISSORS and MASKING TAPE

TABLE COVERING AS THE GLUING GETS MESSY.

REFERENCE PHOTOS. I WILL BE WORKING ON A FUNKY CHICKEN BUT FEEL FREE TO BRING PHOTO'S OF ANY SUBJECT. BIRDS AND ANIMALS DO WORK WELL AS DOES LANDSCAPES AND FLOWERS.
