Subject: QCFAPC Member-Needs-to-Know

Welcome to the Quail Creek Fine Arts Painting Club! The Fine Arts Studio is a beautiful 1,600 SF space with large windows and a covered patio area. We share the studio with two other clubs. **Each club, and its members, are responsible for keeping the studio clean, tidy, and safe for all to enjoy.** A trained monitor from **EACH** club must be on duty when its members are present.

Check out our website at qcfapc.com as soon as possible. Navigate around to find important information such as class schedules, membership information, club meetings and activities, instructors bio, and MORE!

We rely on each member to maintain cleanliness of the studio. Please observe these important safety guidelines.

GENERAL SAFETY AND CLEANLINESS

- **SIGN IN AND SIGN OUT** each time you use the studio. The monitor will place the proper sign-in sheet on the counter
- **ALL** members share responsibility for maintaining community areas: sinks, surfaces, trash cans, floor, equipment
- Perform tasks that cause a lot of dust outside
- Bring and remove your supplies for each use. Do not store solvents in the studio

PERSONAL WORK AREA

- **TABLE:** Protect work area with a table plastic covering for **ANY** type of artwork (painting, pastel, drawing, scratchboard). Shake off residue outside, on cover, or wastebasket. **DO NOT shake off residue on the floor**
- **ACRYLICS, OILS, PASTELS:** Protect the floor with a plastic drop cloth under easel. Make sure the drop cloth material is resistant to the solvents used
- **EASELS:** Line the drip shelf with aluminum foil. Wipe off wet paint and remove foil before returning easel to its storage location
- **WORK SPACE:** Clean workspace and wipe off wet paint on chairs, tables, trash can lids before you leave the studio. **Pay special attention to scraping or wiping off spilled paint on the floor**

APPROVED SUBSTANCES TO USE AT FINE ARTS STUDIO

- **INSIDE STUDIO:** Water, alcohol, masking fluids, turpenoid, gambol, household glues, water-based oils and facilitators
- **OUTSIDE STUDIO:** Hazardous substances such as varnish, fixatives, real turpentine, aerosol sprays must be used OUTSIDE, with caution and regard for facility maintenance
- **STORAGE:** There is no storage for personal supplies in the studio. Please remove after each use.

Nothing should be left in the studio. Nothing removed. Thank you for doing your part in maintaining the Fine Arts Studio as a great place to create arts.
